

## Safety During Social Activities

- Always go out with a group of friends. Never party alone.

## Secure Your Home

- Keep doors and windows locked at all times.

## Personal Safety

## Protect Your Vehicle

- Lock your doors.

- Avoid leaving items such as iPods, laptops, book bags, purses, wallets, and coins.
- If you hear something suspicious (shattering glass) or see someone looking into vehicles, call 911.
